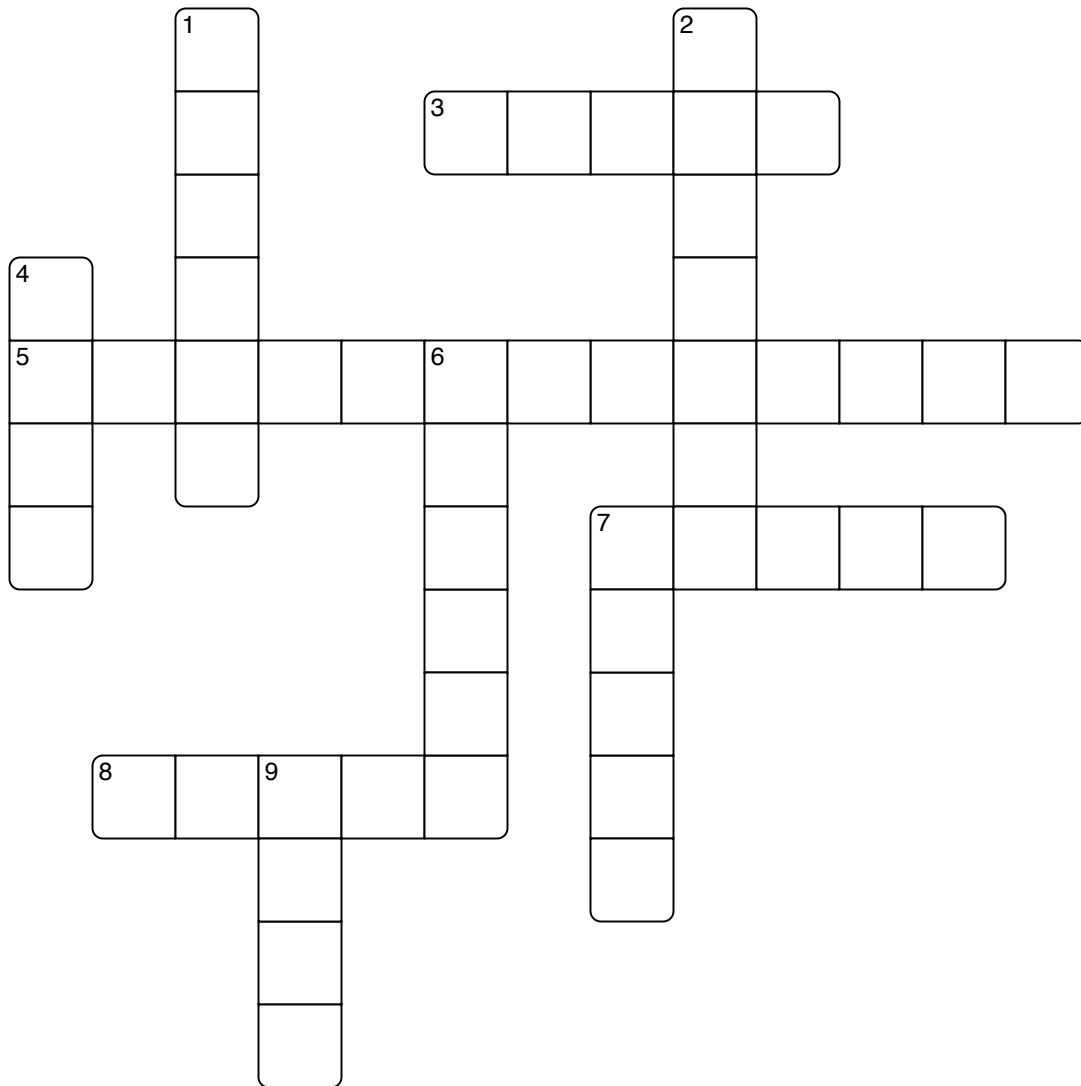


# Transpiration

3. Used for anchorage and the absorption of water and minerals.
5. The loss of water from the surface of a leaf.
7. Anhydrous Copper Sulphate turns from white to blue to confirm this.
8. Tissue used to transport water and dissolved minerals.
