Third Year Expenses: €200.00

This covers the cost of student personal accident insurance, Mock Exams, photocopying, school journal, workshops, guest speakers and a subscription to "Study Clix which the school subsidises.

Journals will only be given to students upon verification of payment on the first day back to school.

Payment can be made using "Easypayments Plus", the online payment system. Log onto www.loretoalbriggan.ie and click the Easypay icon. Please bring receipt or receipt number to the school on the first day.



First instalment €80 must be paid prior to reopening. Balance will be taken automatically in 4 monthly payments from date of 1st payment. There is also an option to pay in full.

Voluntary contributions are vitally important in the day to day running and upkeep of the school. The standard contribution is €175, per student, or €250 per family, per annum, however any amount, more or less, is welcome and can be paid at any point during the academic year.
